Calendar – 187 Days (171 Instructional Days, 1 Opening Day, 6 Planning Days, 4 Professional Development Days, 4 Holidays and 1 Closing Day)

Beginning with the 2007-2008 School Year HB 380 added two additional student instructional days, increasing the number of yearly instructional hours for students from 1050 hours to 1062 hours. There is also a stipulation in this bill that districts must provide two more instructional days than was provided in the 2005-06 School Calendar. Seven instructional days are made-up through an additional fifteen minutes of daily instructional time provided during the school year. Six of these banked instructional days are taken out of the student instructional calendar days and are shown as planning days.
