**College and Career Readiness Celebration** is for those students who have met CCR benchmarks. Invitations will be given to those who are to attend. Hot dogs, chips, cake and drinks. Corn Hole, Football and other games. Held behind gym in parking lot.

**Annual Senior Breakfast** is for all seniors and their guardians to attend. Held in the cafeteria. Breakfast will include biscuits, ham, potatoes, pastries, donuts, orange juice, coffee, milk as well as other food items. Invitations will be given to seniors with a form to be returned to counselors' office.

**Senior Group Picture** is taken each year in cap and gown and all graduation accessories. Picture will be taken in the gym.

**Senior Walk Through** is a celebration of graduation and accomplishment. Seniors will walk through the halls of all schools dressed in caps and gowns to the applause of younger children and former teachers. Sure to be a teary moment for many.

**Graduation Practice** will be held in the gym on two days. Seniors walking the graduation line must be at practice in order to have a seat in the ceremony.

**Senior Awards Night** is to honor the accomplishments of graduating seniors. Scholarships and awards will be given to seniors from guests and school staff. We recommend khakis for gentlemen and dresses for ladies. Held in the gymnasium. Family and friends are invited. Open seating.

**Graduation** will be held in the gymnasium. Again we ask for khakis and dresses. Two early admission tickets will be given out for seniors to give to parents/guardians/important guests. These will be handed out at graduation practice. Seniors should report to the cafeteria by 6:00 before graduation.

**Outstanding Balances** must be paid before a student can receive their diploma. Please check to see if you owe lunch charges, library fines or books, have uniforms out or classroom books out. Diplomas are held until all balances are paid.
